TRAINING REGULATIONS ON THE PROFESSION

SEWER IN AUTOMOTIVE INDUSTRY - SADDLERY

The vocational program saddlery is focused on the following areas:

- 1. equestrianism saddlery
- 2. bag making
- 3. vehicle saddlery

In addition to the general part, the teaching company has to provide at least one additional area. Additional training in individual skills and knowledge of other areas is possible.

In any case, the area must be indicated in the apprenticeship contract by means of a corresponding reference to the title of the vocational profession.

PROFESSIONAL PROFILE

Saddlery – specialisation vehicle upholstery

- a) Selection of materials according to customer requirements,
- b) processing and cutting of leather and other materials,
- c) Sewing of leather parts and related materials by hand and with machines,
- d) Manufacturing of upholstery made from different upholstery materials
- e) Upholstering and covering of vehicle seats, headrests and other objects (such as sanitary stretcher),
- f) covering of steering wheels, gearshift levers and dashboards with leather and plastics,
- g) Measuring, cutting, assembling and mounting of tarps and covers,
- h) Mounting of vehicle inner linings,
- i) Repair and restoration of interior trims, tarpaulins and roofing,
- i) Advising customers on the care of the products and the design of interior trims,
- k) Carrying out the work with respect to the the relevant safety regulations,
- l) standards and environmental standards.

The vocational program saddlery is focused on the following areas: Vehicle upholstering, equestrianism upholstering, bag making.

Saddlery is all about leather. Depending on the focus of their training, they are specialists in the interior furnishing of vehicles (e.g. upholstering), vehicle roofs (convertible hoods) and tarpaulins for trucks.


